ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF WARNING: POWER WHILE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: Before installing ,consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirement

- 1. Put space tube (G) onto the socket (F).
- 2. Thread 2 mounting screws properly into the relevant mounting holes pre-drilled on the cross bar.
- 3. Attach the cross bar to outlet box using 2 outlet box screws upwards.
- 4. Make wire connections:
 - - Attach ground wire to house ground wire using a wire nut (or attach them to the cross bar with a green ground screw).
 - - Attach ribbed wire from light to white wire from power source with a wire nut.
 - - Attach smooth wire from light to black wire from power source with a wire nut.
- 5. Tuck the wire connections neatly into the outlet box.
- 6. Attach the fixture body to the ceiling and let the 2 mounting screws protrude through the 2 pre-drilled keyholes on the canopy and fix it in place by ball nuts (K).
- 7. Turn power on at fuse or circuit box.

YOU CAN ALSO INSTALL THIS FIXTURE AS A PENDANT ACCORDING TO THE FOLLOWING STEPS (SEE FIG.A):

- 1 Thread the fixture loop (A) onto the nipple (B) tightly.
- 2. Thread hex nut (D) onto nipple (C) properly, then slide the washer on the nipple (C) and let it set over the hex nut.
- 3. Assemble the cross bar to outlet box using 2 outlet box screws upwards.
- 4. Determine the length of the chain you need using pliers to disconnect the extra chain and discard it away.
- 5. Weave fixture wires and ground wire through the every other chain links, top nut, canopy, top loop and nipple (C); secure the top loop to the nipple (C) and hang the chain to the top loop and the fixture loop.
- 6. Make wire connections:
 - - Attach ground wire to house ground wire using a wire nut (or attach them to the cross bar with a green ground screw).
 - - Attach ribbed wire from light to white wire from power source with a wire nut.
 - --- Attach smooth wire from light to black wire from power source with a wire nut.
- 7. Tuck the wire connections neatly into the outlet box.
- 8. Attach the canopy to the ceiling, then secure with top nut.
- 9. Turn power on at fuse or circuit box.
