
ASSEMBLY AND INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

WARNING: TO AVOID RISK OF ELECTRICAL SHOCK, BE SURE TO SHUT OFF POWER WHILE INSTALLING OR SERVICING THIS FIXTURE.

NOTE: Before installing, consult local electrical codes for wiring and grounding requirement.

Installation Steps

- Carefully unpack your new fixture and lay out all the parts on clear area. Take care not to lose any small parts necessary for installation.
- 2. Assemble the threaded nipple onto the cross bar and lock it in place by hex nut.
- 3. Attach the cross bar to outlet box by using two mounting screws upwards.
- 4. Fasten the threaded pipe to connector and tighten with hex nut then slide tube and cap through the threaded pipe and tighten with the threaded connector.
- 5. Determine the quantity/length of pipe/pipes needed.
- 6. Determine the length of chain needed, using pliers to disconnect the unneeded chain.
- Feed the wires through the first pipe then thread the pipe onto the threaded connector.
- 8. Thread one threaded nipple onto the pipe to connect the next pipe length.
- 9. After last pipe is attached, attach fixture loop.
- Connect desired chain length using chain links. Put one chain link on the fixture loop and the other one on screw collar.
- 11. Weave fixture wires and ground wire through the fixture loop, every other chain, through the screw collar, collar ring, canopy and threaded nipple on the cross bar.
- 12. Make wire connections:
 - --Attach ground wire to house ground wire using a wire nut or attach them to the cross bar with a green ground screw.
 - --Attach white or ribbed wire(neutral) from light to white wire from power source with a wire nut.
 - --Attach black or smooth wire(hot) from light to black wire from power source with a wire nut.
 - Observing: ground wire with ground wire, neutral wire with neutral wire, hot wire with hot wire.
 - ***Make sure all wire connectors are secured and do not easily pull off with the slight tug.
- 13. Tuck the wire connections neatly into the outlet box.
- 14. Attach the canopy to the ceiling then thread the screw collar onto the threaded nipple and secure the canopy with the collar ring.
- 15. Slide glass shade to socket and secure glass shade by threading spacer to socket tightly.
- 16. Install bulbs.(not included) (Please do not exceed the maximum capacity which is recommended on the fixture.)
- 17. Turn on the power at the fuse or circuit box.
